Psalm 106

Psalm 106

- This psalm recounts Israel's history of rebellion and faithlessness in contrast to God's enduring faithfulness and mercy.
- It acknowledges Israel's sins from Egypt to the promised land.
- Despite Israel's ingratitude and rebellion, God still delivered them for the sake of His name and covenant.

Psalm 106:1-5

Praise and Prayer:

It opens with a call to praise God for His steadfast love, while asking for restoration and salvation for Israel.

Psalm 106:6-46

Historical Review of Sin:

It recalls the rebellion of Israel at the Red Sea, in the wilderness, and their idolatry and disobedience in Canaan.

Historical Review of Sin:

- In Egypt (6-12)
- In the Wilderness (13-33)
- In Canaan (34-30)
- In Captivity (40-46)

Psalm 106:47-48

God's Mercy and Hope:

This psalm ends with a plea for God to gather the exiles from the nations and a declaration of praise to Him.

“Praise the LORD!”
