# Philippians 1

- Prison created opportunities to spread the Gospel
- Whether Paul lives or dies—it will be a blessing

# Philippians 2

- Paul presents how to live a life of sacrificial service to God
- It means to have the same mind that is seen in Christ
- Examples of Paul, Timothy and Epaphroditus are before them
